FROM OUR COOKBOOK



California Rolls

<u>Ingredients</u>

1 cup (215g) sushi rice 1 cup (250ml) cold water

1/3 cup low-fat mayonnaise 2 hard-boiled eggs, peeled

1 cucumber, finely chopped 1 carrot, peeled, finely chopped

1 tablespoon hoisin sauce 4 nori sheets

1/2 ripe avocado, stone removed, peeled, sliced

Method:

- 1. Rinse rice, drain.
- Cover rice with water and bring to the boil. Reduce heat to low and cook, covered, for 12 minutes or until water has absorbed. Set aside, covered, to cool slightly.
- 3. Meanwhile, combine the mayonnaise and eggs in a bowl. Use a fork to mash until smooth.
- 4. Combine the cucumber, carrot and hoisin sauce in a howl
- Place 1 nori sheet, shiny-side down, on a sushi mat. Use wet hands to spread one-quarter of the rice over the nori sheet, leaving a 2cm border at 1 short end.
- Spread one-quarter of the egg mixture over the rice.
 Top with one-quarter of the cucumber mixture. Top with avocado slices. Roll sushi mat up firmly to enclose the filling. Repeat to make 3 more rolls.

HEAD LICE PREVENTION

We have had a number of children presenting with head lice at school. This is not unusual at this time of year, and we must remember that children can catch head lice by just walking past someone who has already got them anywhere.

To minimize the spread of head lice it is important that parents check their child's hair regularly – at least once a week. If you find the small eggs – or even think you do – treat your child's hair with special head lice shampoo and use a fine comb to remove all eggs. Remember regular shampoo, including tea tree and dandruff shampoo will not get rid of head lice.

It is also advised that children with long hair wear it in a ponytail or plaits.
