# FROM OUR COOKBOOK



### Avocado & Chicken Risotto

### Ingredients

1.25L (5 cups) gluten-free vegetable stock25g unsalted butter1 tbs olive oil1 onion, finely chopped3 garlic cloves, crushed2 cups Arborio rice2/3 cup dry white wine500g chicken breast1 cup grated parmesan2 avocados¼ cup roughly chopped chives

#### Method

- 1. Place the stock in a saucepan, bring to the boil,
- 2. Heat the butter and olive oil in the rice cooker, add the onion and garlic, cook until brown.
- 3. Add the rice, vegetable stock and white wine.
- 4. While cooking add herbs to taste.
- 5. In frypan season and cook chicken.
- 6. Peel the avocados and dice.
- 7. Just before serving risotto add chicken and stir, then add avocado and stir.
- 8. Top with parmesan and chives.
