FROM OUR COOKBOOK



Ingredients:

- 125gm butter
- 1/3 cup Brown sugar 3 cups plain flour
- ¹/₂ cup golden syrup
- 2 teasp ground ginger 2 to ¹/₂ teasp ground clove 2 t
- r 2 teasp ground cinnamon
 - 2 teasp bicarb soda 1 teasp vanilla extract
- 1 egg, lightly beaten 1 Method:
- Method: 1. Preheat oven to moderate. Lightly grease oven trays.
 - Heat butter, sugar and golden syrup in small microwave bowl uncovered on HIGH in microwave oven about 1 minute or until butter is melted. Remove from microwave and let cool for 5 minutes.
 - 3. Sift combined flour, spices and soda into large bowl, add butter mixture, egg and extract, stir with wooden spoon until combined.
 - Knead dough lightly on floured surface, using rolling pin roll dough out to 5mm thickness. Using gingerbread man cutter, cut out shapes, place on oven trays.
 - 5. Bake, uncovered, in moderate oven about 10 minutes or until golden brown. Cool on trays.

Royal Icing:

1 egg white 1 cup pure icing sugar Food colourings

Beat egg white in small bowl with electric mixer until just frothy; gradually add sifted icing sugar, beating between additions, until stiff peaks form. Tint icing as desired, using various food colourings.
