Eggplant Dip with Sesame Oil

Ingredients:

2 med dark skinned eggplant (pierce with fork to allow steam to escape)

4 cloves garlic Juice of 1 lemon Salt & pepper Chopped parsley Pomegranate seeds 6 tblsp tahini 2 tblsp water Pinch of cayenne pepper Toasted pine nuts

Method:

- 1. <u>Broil</u> eggplants with skin on, turning frequently until skin is lightly charred and eggplants are fairly soft. Alternately, slice eggplants in half lengthways and place on an oiled cookie sheet.
- 2. Broil in oven or bake at 450o until fairly soft. Allow to cool enough to be handled.
- 3. Remove skin and mash eggplant. If you don't mind a little greyness in the colour, allow a little charred skin in with the pulp, it will add a pleasant smoky flavour.
- Place garlic cloves, tahini, lemon juice and water in a blender until thoroughly combined. Add eggplant and pulse until coarsely pureed. Add salt and peppers to taste.

5. Refrigerate for 1-2 hours.

Serve with pita bread or vegies
