EGYPTIAN CHICKPEA AND CORZO SOUP

Ingredients:

6 cups vegetable broth
2 cups water
6 garlic cloves, thinly sliced
1 Small onion, chopped
1 1/2 cups cooked chickpeas, drained
1 tblsp parsley, chopped
3 cups corzo or small pasta
2 lemons cut into wedges
Salt & pepper

Method:

1. Combine the broth, water, garlic and onion in a saucepan over medium heat until the onion is cooked.
2. Add the chickpeas and cook for 15 minutes.
3. Add salt & pepper, stir in parsley
4. Cook pasta in boiled water until tender, drain
5. Serve pasta with the soup with a few drops of lemon.
