LOCATION: The interviews occur in the hall from 2:15pm till 6:30pm. Due to the size of our school, we will conduct some interviews in the adjacent classrooms. 5E, 6P and 6N will be in 5E's classroom. 5B, 6A and 4/5G will be in 5B's classroom.

CHANGED STARTING/FINISHING TIMES

After an extensive period of consultation and trialing solutions, we will go ahead with the following model:
Year 3 to 6

Bell times remain the same, 9:15am till 3pm.

K – 2

Students will start learning at 9am and finish at 2:45pm. At 8:45am, students will move to the Infants Cola where they will line up at 9am ready to move into class. At 2:45pm, students have the option of leaving and a teacher will be waiting at the top and bottom gate to ensure students depart safely. Students also have the option of waiting till 3pm to depart with older siblings.

Only parents whose children are departing before 3pm are permitted to use the kiss and drop zone during this 15 minute period.

I ask that parents please park their car and walk to school during the afternoon pick up which will avoid the long line of cars banked up from the kiss and drop point.
