EXCURSIONS AND PAYMENTS TO THE OFFICE

Please see the following information. To ensure smooth running of excursions, you are reminded:

- Online payments made through 'Make a Payment' tab on the school website still require the permission note from the bottom of the excursion note.
- When making cash payments at the school office, please come with the correct money as change will be unavailable.
- Payments made after the due date will not be accepted. There is a lot of time to make payments for excursions and advising that payment could not be made in time, because the child has been away is not an excuse. Payments can be made online. Email reminders are sent a few days before the due date to give parents the opportunity to pay. Please update your email address at the school office as the school would not like for the students to miss out on attending excursions.
- On the day of the excursion, please send your child to school with their school hat. Hat purchases or borrowing can not be arranged on the morning of the excursion.

CHILD PROTECTION

In government schools, child protection education forms part of all students' learning in Personal Development Health and Physical Education from Kindergarten to Year 10. Students learn skills in recognising if they could be unsafe and strategies for protecting themselves. Strategies including saying 'no' if they can, going away from the situation and telling a trusted adult what has happened as soon as possible. If you would like to discuss the content further or have any concerns, please speak to your child's class teacher.

BUILDING PROGRESS SUMMARY from SCHOOLS INFRASTRUCTURE NSW

The construction contract has been awarded to Barbro Construction and site establishment has commenced in preparation for early works.

Works update

Site establishment is currently underway at Banksia Road Public School. Hoarding and fencing have been installed around the perimeter of the works site and a new internal walkway has been established for students and staff to move safely around the construction site. Staff will be on site to supervise student movements on the new internal walkway. The Banksia Road school entrance will continue to operate as normal. Early works have commenced including demolition of a portion of the car park and excavation works.

Construction vehicle movements

Construction vehicles will use the staff carpark for the duration of works. The vehicles will arrive on site before school drop off times and traffic control will be monitoring the driveway. Deliveries will be scheduled outside of school drop off and pick up times and can be made at the Boronia Road entrance.

Traffic management

During construction, traffic management will be implemented to ensure the safety of students, teachers, staff, site visitors and residents. Measures will be in place to mitigate noise and dust levels, including hoarding, hosing down of vehicles as required and deliveries will be scheduled outside of pick up and drop off times where possible.

Kiss and drop zone

The kiss and drop zone on Banksia Road will continue to operate using the number system set in place last term. For more information on the kiss and drop zone please see the information above or contact the school.

Construction hours

Construction will take place between 7.00am to 5.00pm Monday to Friday, and 8.00am and 1.00pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless approval and notification is provided.

KISS AND DROP PICK UP PROCEDURE

Thursday 19th September will see the site establishment for the new building.

As from Thursday afternoon the new Kiss and Drop process will start.

If you have registered to use the "Kiss & Drop" you will receive two printed cards. 3.00pm pick up will be orange and 3.10pm pick up will be green. If another family member is picking up your child you will need to share this card.

This is to be clearly displayed on the front window passenger side of your car -maybe with BluTak. As shown in photo below:



If you do not have a number you are unable to use the "Kiss and Drop" area.

Students will wait on the footpath with the same coloured card to match your car and when you approach the Kiss and Drop area a supervisor will help your child to the car.

If your child is not waiting at the Kiss and Drop you will be instructed to drive on and turn right at Noble Avenue and continue around the block to rejoin the queue. See map on the next page.

Please follow any instructions given by our supervisors. We need your co-operation and patience to ensure this process is successful.
