#### **COVID COMMUNICATION**

If we have a COVID case on site, a letter will be sent home to all parents.

For example; If a child tests positive in say a Year 1 class, all those students in that particular class will be considered close contacts and will be required to self-isolate for 14 days given they have spent greater than 15 minutes inside a room together.

Students who spend between 1 to 15 minutes inside a room together may be considered casual contacts and will be asked to get tested and return upon a negative result.

Contact outside in the playground is not considered.

It is critical that your email address is up to date as NSW Health send out a bulk email to all parents.

#### **OUR SCHOOL'S COVID SAFE OPERATIONS**

Our COVID-safe return to school plan is NSW Health approved and includes numerous effective practices to support the health and wellbeing of our students and staff. These practices include vaccinations, mask wearing, reduced mingling of student groups and staff, air purifiers in classrooms and continued good hygiene and cleaning.

# KEEPING STUDENT GROUPS TOGETHER REPEAT

As we return to school students will be kept in their cohorts to minimise opportunities for transmission of COVID-19 and to enable effective contact tracing and containment. This means minimising interaction between students on school grounds and keeping cohorts together where possible.
