STUDENT ILLNESS

During the past week, several students have presented with runny noses and/or unwell.

As you can appreciate, with school closures now becoming more frequent due to positive cases of covid it is important that as a school community we remain vigilant in maintaining expected protocols.

Please note the following advice which is still current: "Staff and students must not attend work or school if unwell, even with mild symptoms of COVID-19.

Any person with any COVID-19 symptoms must be sent home and not return to school unless:

- they have a negative COVID-19 test result and are symptom free or
- they have isolated for 10 days, when no medical certificate is available.

In circumstances where students or staff have other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms, a letter from their GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test."

Similar to RESPECT, it would run once a week across 2 terms for a cohort of around 12 girls.


We are excited to be the only school as part of this pilot program.
