#### **CAMP**



Thank you to our P & C for coordinating the Father's Day Stall. It was a great event and I am sure the dad's appreciated the gifts they received from their children.


#### **CANTERBURY BANKSTOWN LIBRARY VISIT**

As this training is subsidised with the NSW Government, eligibility criteria applies.




