CHECK- IN ASSESSMENTS

Check- In Assessments for Years 3, 4 & 5 will occur during the next 4 weeks.

Check-in assessments are online assessments for students in Years 3 to 9. They are mapped to the NSW Syllabuses and National Literacy and Numeracy Learning Progressions. All students complete a reading assessment and a numeracy assessment.

Each assessment is designed to be easy to administer. Assessments are designed to take up to 60 minutes each, however, there is no time limit for the assessments (allow students extra time if required).

The reading and numeracy assessments have approximately 50 questions (including a small number of questions for trial purposes).

Schools can access feedback soon after the completion of the assessment. Student assessment feedback, including links to teaching strategies, is available in Scout. The feedback is also mapped against the National Literacy and Numeracy Learning Progressions and can be accessed in PLAN2.

The assessment can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.
