WHY TEACHING SEGMENTING?

Segmenting words involves breaking down a word into each of its <u>phonemes</u> and <u>graphemes</u>. Phoneme is a term that just means a unit of sound, while graphemes are the groups of letters that are used to represent these sound.

Segmenting is a vital skill that your child will learn through phonics lessons at BRPS. By segmenting words into their different sounds, your child will be able to see how a word is sounded out and written down. This will help them develop their reading and writing skills in the long run.
